Cemetery Fees and Regulation Effective from 1st April 2019 – 31st March 2020.

FOR RESIDENTS OF DONINGTON-ON-BAIN

Exclusive Right of Burial for 50 years

Grave space	£220
Cremation plot	£55
Ten-year extension to Exclusive Right of Burial	£10

Interment

Still-born / child up to one year	NIL
Child from one year and under twelve year	£50
Twelve years of age and over	£100
Cremated remains in existing grave*	£55
Cremated remains in cremation plot	£55

Memorials*

Headstone not exceeding 2ft 6ins in height	£80.00
Memorial vase not exceeding 12ins in height	£22.00
With base if fitted not exceeding 12ins x 12ins	£22.00
Plaque not exceeding 12ins x 12ins	£22.00
Plaque not exceeding 18ins x 18ins	£27.50
Second or subsequent inscription	£44.00

FOR NON-RESIDENTS OF DONINGTON-ON-BAIN – All the above fees are doubled

When a resident moves away from Donington-on-Bain because of health reasons (ie into a nursing home or to live with relatives for care needs) they will be charged as resident as long as their last known address was in Donington-on-Bain.

SEARCH OF RECORDS £15.00

A grant of Exclusive Right of Burial will apply to all plots for burial and cremated remains. Permission for memorials, or interment of cremated remains in existing graves will only be permitted where a grant of Exclusive Right of Burial has been purchased.

Payment for interment in the Cemetery only will give no such rights to a grave space or plot. Written application can be made to the Clerk at the end of the fifty-year period for a ten-year extension to the grant of Exclusive Right of Burial on payment of the fee applicable at the time.

All applications to erect memorials should be submitted to the Clerk to the Parish Council in duplicate with a sketch of the headstone, full measurements and particulars of inscription. Kerbs are not permitted.
